CHAPTER 2

QuickBooks Online Setup – Do It Right the First Time

1. Choose the right plan
2. Set up your chart of accounts
3. Connect all bank and credit card feeds.
4. Set up Kentucky sales tax. (6% flat rate)
5. Turn on Class or Location tracking if needed.

Action Step:

Log in today and verify all bank feeds are connected and reconciled to the latest statement date.



CHAPTER 3

Mistake #1 – Treating QuickBooks Like a Check Register

Many owners only enter deposits and payments without proper categorization.

Why it hurts

- Profit & Loss reports become meaningless
- Missed deductions at tax time
- Higher IRS audit risk

Fix in QuickBooks Online

- Always categorize every transaction
- Use "Find & Match" for bank feeds
- Review Income and Expense accounts monthly

Pro Tip: Spend 15 minutes every Friday categorizing new transactions.



CHAPTER 4:

MISTAKE #2 – SKIPPING MONTHLY BANK RECONCILIATIONS

Step-by-step fix

STEP 1:

Go to Banking → Select account → Reconcile

STEP 2:

Enter statement ending date and balance

STEP 3:

Match all transactions (difference must be \$0.00)

STEP 4:

Click Reconcile Now



BEST PRACTICE:

KEEP A SIMPLE EXCEL BACKUP LOG EACH MONTH

Kentucky Note:

Reconcile before filing sales tax or payroll returns.

Flag for CPA:

Final tax returns must be reviewed by your CPA.



CHAPTER 5:

Mistake #3 – Ignoring Sales Tax Tracking in Kentucky

KENTUCKY HAS A FLAT 6% STATE SALES TAX RATE (NO ADDITIONAL LOCAL RATES).

Setup Steps

1. Taxes → Sales Tax → Set up
2. Add Kentucky – 6% combined rate
3. Assign tax rate to taxable items
4. Apply tax on every taxable invoice

Filing:

Run Sales Tax Liability report → File via [MyTaxes.ky.gov](https://mytaxes.ky.gov) or in QuickBooks.

Action Step:

Confirm your 6% rate is active and run a current liability report.

Flag for CPA:

Sales tax returns (Form 51A102) must be reviewed and filed by your CPA.

CHAPTER 6

Mistake #4 – Poor Expense Categorization & Missing Deductions

Why it happens

Bank feeds auto-categorize incorrectly and owners rush through entries.

Real cost

Overpaying taxes and missing legitimate deductions (mileage, home office, meals).

Fix in QuickBooks Online

1. Transactions → Bank transactions
2. Categorize or Split each transaction
3. Create Rules for automation
4. Use Tags for mileage, client meals, etc.

Action item:

Review uncategorized transactions every Friday.

Flag for CPA:

Final deductible vs. non-deductible decisions should be reviewed by your CPA.

CHAPTER 7:

Mistake #5 – Not Setting Up Classes or Locations

Why it hurts

You cannot see true profitability by service line or job.

Setup Steps

1. Gear icon → Account and settings → Advanced → Turn on Classes/Locations
2. Create your categories
3. Assign to every transaction and invoice line

Run Profit & Loss by Class monthly.

Action item:

Turn on Classes today and assign to recent transactions.

CHAPTER 8:

Mistake #6 – Payroll Setup & Reporting Errors

Fix in QuickBooks

Add employees/contractors with correct tax info
Set up payroll schedule
Reconcile payroll liabilities monthly

Kentucky Note:

Stay current on state withholding and unemployment reports.

Flag for CPA:

Payroll tax deposits, Form 941, W-2s, and 1099s must be reviewed and filed by your CPA.

CHAPTER 9

Mistake #7 – Failing to Review Key Financial Reports Monthly

Must-Review Reports Every Month

Running your business without looking at reports is like driving with your eyes closed. Many owners only look at their bank balance.

| Report | Purpose |
|---------------------------|--------------------|
| Profit and Loss | True Profitability |
| Balance sheet | Financial position |
| Cash flow statement | Cash movement |
| Accounts Receivable Aging | Collections |
| Accounts Payable Aging | Bills due |

Action item:

Block 30 minutes on the 10th of each month for Financial Review Day

CHAPTER 10

Mistake #8 – Mixing Personal & Business Transactions

This is the fastest way to create bookkeeping chaos and IRS problems.

Why it hurts

- Complicates tax preparation
- Triggers audit red flags
- Makes accurate profit tracking impossible

Fix

- Open separate business bank and credit card accounts
- Never pay personal expenses from business accounts
- Record owner draws only through Owner's Draw account

Action item:

Separate all accounts this week. Move any mixed transactions to the correct accounts.

Flag for CPA:

Owner draws and distributions should be reviewed by your CPA.

CHAPTER 11

Mistake #9 – Not Backing Up or Securing Your Data

QuickBooks data is valuable – and vulnerable.

Best Practices

- Enable automatic backups in QuickBooks Online (already cloud-based).
- Turn on two-factor authentication (Gear → Account and settings → Billing & Subscription).
- Export key reports monthly to Excel/PDF and store in a secure folder (Google Drive or Dropbox with 2FA).
- Use strong, unique passwords.

Action Item

Enable 2FA today and schedule monthly report exports.

CHAPTER 12

Mistake #10 – Waiting Until Tax Season to Fix Everything

TAX SEASON PANIC IS EXPENSIVE AND AVOIDABLE.

Why you should fix now

Cleaner books = lower CPA fees
Time to claim missed deductions
Better cash-flow decisions all year

Action item

Start your 30-day cleanup today (see Chapter 13). Don't wait until January.

Flag for CPA:

All tax returns must be prepared and reviewed by your licensed CPA.
